

Callerton Academy Transition Week x NUF

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are delighted to write to you to announce that Callerton Academy and Newcastle United Foundation are partnering over the Summer School Holidays to help deliver two transition weeks to help students on their journeys to Year 7 at Callerton from September.

During both weeks Callerton and NUF staff will deliver a range of activities at Callerton Academy, NUCASTLE & St James' Park. The activities will include football, Multi sports, teamwork games, Esports Gaming & HADO (Augmented Dodgeball). There will also be an opportunity to attend a free tour of St James Park. Students can wear casual clothing with but please ensure they are comfortable for physical activity throughout each day i.e. trainers, tracksuit bottoms, jacket for cold/wet weather.

Each day your child will be transported by coach to the venues. The pickup and drop off point will be Simonside Primary School on Bedeburn Road. They will also receive a **free** lunch each day.

Each day will run from 10am – 2pm. We would encourage all students to use the bus provided to allow staff to track registers easier, however if you would like to use alternative travel to the venues, you will have the option to notify us on your confirmation email.

The dates are as follows:

Monday 29th July – Wednesday 31st July Callerton Academy

Thursday 30th July – NUCASTLE (Newcastle United Foundation)

Monday 19th August – Wednesday 21st August – Callerton Academy

Thursday 22nd August – St James Park

The bus will depart from Simonside each day at 9:30am (please arrive from 9:15am for registration) and depart each venue from 2pm to return to Simonside for approx. 2:20pm.

All students invited to this event are students that will be attending Callerton Academy from September 2024.

Lunches for 3 days each week will be a packed lunch with a sandwich, snack, bottle of water and piece of fruit, on confirming your child's place you will have the opportunity to select from Ham, Cheese, Chicken or Tuna.

As a treat on your child's visit to NUCASTLE and SJP, we will be providing a pizza and chips meal.

You are also more than welcome to provide your child with their own packed lunch each day, if you feel they may not like what is on offer. We'd also advise an additional water bottle to refill during the days as well.

Any dietary, medical needs can be stated on your child's registration application.
